Once again, The Welcome Mat is assisting with registration and pooling. Anyone who has attended their tournaments knows that they are well-run and we are happy to be using that system again.



The pools will be set up as fairly as possible while ensuring adequate competition. Age is determined by legal age as of the tournament date. Each age division will be divided into weight groupings as determined by entries. Our goal is to keep Junior divisions within 10% of the lowest non-upgrade weight. Mixed gender pools will only be allowed in for 8 years and under. With permission of parents and coach, girls may request to play in a boy's pool, but not vice-versa. Granting any request is at the sole discretion of the Tournament Director.
